GNU General Public License version 2 (GPL2)

This is a human-readable summary of (and not a substitute for) GPL2.

(This summary highlights only some of the key terms of GPL2. It is not a license and has no legal value. You should carefully review all of the terms of the actual license before using the licensed program.)

You are free to:

Share – copy and distribute the program

Adapt – modify the program or any part of it and distribute the modifications or new work

Charge – a fee for transferring a copy of the program and/or for warranty protection

for any purpose, even commercially.

Under the following terms:

Notices – you must publish on each copy of the program an appropriate copyright notice and disclaimer of warranty, keep intact all notices that refer to GPL2 and the absence of any warranty, and give recipients a copy of GPL2 along with the program.

Modified files - must contain notices regarding the existence and date of changes.

ShareAlike – any work that you distribute or publish that contains or is derived from the program or any part of it must be licensed as a whole at no charge to all third parties under the GPL. If identifiable sections of the overall work are not derived from the Program and can be considered independent and separate works in themselves, then GPL2 does not apply to those sections when you distribute them as separate works. In addition, mere aggregation of another work not based on the program with the program (or with a work based on the program) on a volume of a storage or distribution medium does not bring the other work under the scope GPL2.

Non-source forms – copies of the program and works based on it may be distributed in object code or executable form but only if accompanied with the source code or a written offer to give any third party the source code or (in some instances) information you received as to such offer.

No additional restrictions – you may not impose any further restrictions on the recipients' exercise of the rights granted under GPL2.

Notices:

Termination – if you copy, modify, sublicense or distribute the program other than as permitted, your rights under GPL2 will terminate automatically.

No warranty – there is no warranty for the program and you use it at your own risk. No copyright holder or other party who modifies or redistributes the program as permitted will be liable for damages.
